## HOSPITALIST GROUPS

- Health Texas Provider Network PCP goes to MedProvider (page them on consult screen)
- Any other PCP or no PCP goes to TPC (Texas Primary Care) 9056
- Resident Teaching Service Number – 972-206-9132 (pager)

## ADMITTING VS NON-ADMITTING SERVICES

- Do Not Admit Primarily
- GI (medicine admits)
- Neurology (medicine admits)
- Ophthalmology
- Occasionally or rarely admit
- Urology
- ENT
- Neurosurgery (almost never) - generally this is trauma or medicine
- Cardiology – look up their primary cardiologist as there are three services

## SPECIAL PROCESSES

- Cardiology (transfer to BHVH – Baylor Heart and Vascular Hospital)
- Ortho – fragility fractures admitted by MedProvider if operative

## SHIFT AREAS

- AB – Split A and B
- DE – Split D and E

## TRAUMAS

- You are responsible for airway
- TART 1 – Trauma team and attending come to
- TART 2 – Trauma team without the attending
- TARDIS – Just you – if they need admission you consult trauma (Trauma Level 3 1 hour)

## ICU ADMISSIONS

- You call medicine, not critical care

- Code for nutrition rooms 12345
- Code for staff restrooms and fishbowl consultant area in C 911911
